

ACTIVITY: SETTING UP A SIMPLE MODEL ALTAR

SUPPLIES:

- Small table or bench
- White cloth
- Two candles
- Paten or small plate
- Chalice or cup with stem
- Standing Crucifix or cross
- Small book or Bible (optional)
- Small bell (optional)

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Gather all supplies
- 2. Demonstrate how to set the altar by placing the white cloth on the table and smoothing it out.
- 3. Place the two candles on either side of the altar.
- 4. Place the Crucifix between the candles.
- 5. The chalice and paten are set in front of the Crucifix.

Additional ideas:

- Learn the names of the items on the altar (paten, crucifix, chalice, Roman Missal, etc).
- Cut out circles from flour or corn tortillas and use them as hosts.
- See if you can watch Father at Mass and then imitate his actions at home by holding up the host/chalice. Can you remember the words that he said?
