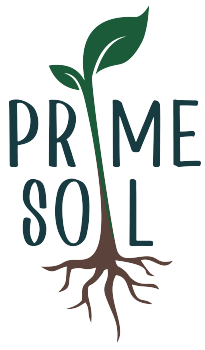

ACTIVITY: MARY GROTTO

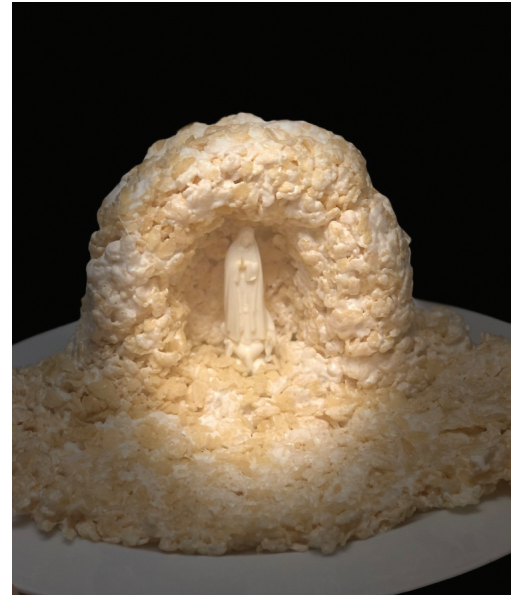
The feast of Our Lady of Fatima is celebrated on May 13th. This year, try making this special grotto for her out of rice krispie treat.

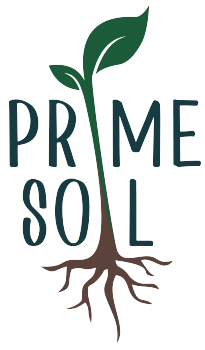
SUPPLIES:

- 6 cups rice krispie cereal
- 1 package marshmallows
- 3 T butter
- Small Mary statue
- Plate or platter

DIRECTIONS:

1. Heat the marshmallows in the microwave with the butter in a glass bowl. Once the butter is melted and the marshmallows are puffy, stir in the cereal, one cup at a time.
 2. Let the mixture cool for 5-10 minutes but not longer or it will harden.
 3. Use clean oiled hands to mold the mixture into a grotto. Start by forming the base on the plate and then build upward to form a little cave or grotto.
 4. Measure the opening with your statue and adjust as needed.
 5. Finally place the statue in the grotto.
- (Optional) Decorate the grotto with candy rocks, grasses, sprinkles, etc.
