ACTIVITY: SACRED HEART OF JESUS & IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY CHOCOLATE COVERED STRAWBERRIES

Celebrate the love Jesus and Mary have for each and everyone of you by making these heart-shaped chocolate covered strawberries and praying the following prayer to the Sacred Heart (see below). This year the Solemnity (or Feast) of the Sacred Heart is celebrated on June 7th and the Feast of the Immaculate Heart on June 8th. As homework, ask your parents to help you look up the twelve promises of the Sacred Heart!

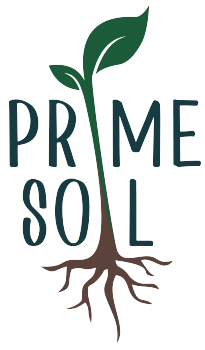
SUPPLIES:

- Strawberries
- Chocolate melting discs (or chocolate chips)
- Short skewers or cake pop sticks (optional)
- Sprinkles (optional)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Wash the strawberries and pat dry with a paper towel.
2. Use a sharp knife (ask a parent to help you!) to cut a 'v' shape to remove the green stem/leaves.
3. Insert the skewers or cake pop sticks (if using) and set aside.
4. Melt the chocolate in a glass bowl in the microwave, only for short increments at a time. Try 20 seconds, stir the chocolate, and heat again if needed.
5. Once the chocolate is melted, dip the tops of the heart-shaped strawberries.
6. Top with sprinkles if desired.
