VIRTUE OF THE MONTH: ORDERLINESS

ACTIVITY:

The Feast of Christ the King is celebrated on November 24th. This is the last Sunday before Advent. It reminds us that Jesus is the true King of our world, our families, and our hearts. Here are some simple ideas to celebrate Christ as the King today and every day. Viva, Christo Rey! Long live Christ the King!

A ROYAL FEAST

Plan, make, and enjoy a royal feast for dinner on November 24th. This could look different for each family but make your favorite fancy foods and don't forget to bring out your best china and light candles (ask an adult for help with this). Dessert afterwards is highly recommended. Perhaps you could make a King Cake or any flavored cake in a crown shape (a bundt cake pan works well!).

PROCESSION

Many parishes will hold a special procession for the Feast of Christ the King. Check with your local parishes or hold a procession of your own. Some songs you could sing are: Crown Him with Many Crowns, To Jesus Christ our Sovereign King, or any other song about Jesus.

DISCUSS CHRIST'S KINGSHIP

What does it mean that Christ is the King? How does the world change with Him as the King? How is your family different with Christ the King of your family? How does your life change with Jesus the King of your heart?

KINGLY CRAFT

In honor of Christ's Kingship, make a kingly crown. Cut paper and fit to the shape of your head. You can use a staple or tape to secure it and add any decorations you'd like. Some ideas are drawing with markers/crayons.
