ACTIVITY:

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 5oz bottle of glow in the dark glue
- tsp baking soda
- 1 Tbsp contact solution (be sure it includes Coric Acid)
- Medium size bowl or tub
- Mixing Spoon
- Glow in the dark stars, beads, etc. (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Squeeze out all glue into the bowl/tub.
2. Add the baking soda. Stir until well combined.
3. Add the contact solution. Stir (or stretch with your fingers!). Don't worry if it feels very sticky or like there is too much contact solution. Keep mixing it together and the consistency will come together!
4. If desired, add in glow in the dark stars or beads for additional texture.
5. Find a dark room or closet and enjoy your slime!
6. Slime can be stored in an airtight container or jar for future use.
