CRAFT: LOOP FLOWER BOUQUET

May is the month of Mary, the month of Mother's Day and the beginning of spring! In honor of our Mother Mary and mothers everywhere, try making a bouquet of loop flowers! Present them to your own mom, or put them at the foot of a statue of Mother Mary to honor her this month!

Supplies:

- Yellow cardstock
- Cardstock in any color of your choosing (for flower petals)
- Green straws
- Green tape
- Scissors or paper cutter
- Glue or glue stick.

Instructions:

1. Cut out circles, about an inch in diameter, out of yellow cardstock.
2. Cut out strips of colored card stock for the petals You can vary the length and thickness for each flower to add variety. Most of our flowers were about 6 inch long strips of paper, about 1/4 inch wide, but you can experiment with shorter, wider or narrower strips!
3. Loop the strip and glue the ends together.
4. After the glue on the loops dry, take the glued ends and glue them around the yellow circle.
5. After the pedals are on, take the green straw and using the green tape, tape it onto the yellow circle on the side where the petals are glued (the back side).
