## CRAFT: SACRED HEART CELLOPHANE SUNCATCHERS

Welcome summer! Summer is in full swing and we can celebrate the SON of God by making Suncatchers! These fun suncatchers can be made in the shape of the sun, or if you want to get more creative, try making an image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus! The Month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart and you can dedicate yourself to loving Jesus while making this craft!

### Supplies:

- Black Cardstock (or yellow or orange cardstock if making suns)
- Cellophane (or tissue paper) in red, orange, yellow
- Exacto Knife
- Scissors
- Clear contact paper



### Instructions:

1. Create a template of the Sacred heart (I printed a coloring page from online and traced it onto cardboard).
2. Use the template to cut out two Sacred Hearts on black cardstock—use the Exacto knife to cut out the interior shapes.
3. Cut a rectangle of contact paper large enough to fit the Sacred Heart.
4. Place one of the black cardstock Sacred Heart outlines on the contact paper. Press it down.
5. Cut the cellophane into pieces, about 1 inch by 1 inch.
6. Place the cellophane pieces over the outline, sticking them to the contact paper.
7. Cut another rectangle of contact paper and place the other black cardstock Sacred Heart outline on it. Make sure it is facing the other direction as the first one so they line up when sandwiched together. Press it down.
8. Take the contact paper with just the Sacred Heart outline and flip it over, placing the sticky side onto the sticky side of the Sacred Heart with cellophane. Press them together.
9. Cut away any extra contact paper around the Sacred Heart.
